USE OF FUNDS AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ESSER III)

As per the American Rescue Plan requirements, 20% of the funds must be allocated to learning loss.

- Akin School District plans to utilize ARP ESSER III funds to Prepare, Prevent, and Respond to Covid 19 to address learning loss our district will allocate 20% or more of these funds from ARP ESSER to employ RtI paraprofessional. \$23457
- Akin School District plans to utilize ARP ESSER III funds to Prepare, Prevent, and Respond to Covid 19 to address learning loss in our district by providing after-school tutoring for any student who needs additional support in all academic areas. \$25282
- Akin School District plans to utilize ARP ESSER III funds to Prepare, Prevent, and Respond to Covid 19 to provide summer learning opportunities for students who need more time and support to master academic learning. Students who need additional support will devices that will be available to practice skills over the summer. There are several educational apps that the students will be able to utilize to reinforce math and reading skills. (Reserve SEA - summer enrichment programs will use \$12.00 for technology devises to teach summer enrichment programs for students who need additional support academically.
- Akin School District plans to utilize ARP ESSER III funds to Prepare, Prevent, and Respond to Covid 19, our district will have available technology for school and home. Classrooms will have technology carts to host Chromebooks and iPads in the classroom. Every student will have a device that will allow are teachers to promote more technology being used in the classroom or at home to address learning loss. (Summer Reserve will help purchase devices to be used at home for the summer - \$12) \$105000
- Akin School District plans to utilize ARP ESSER III funds to Prepare, Prevent, and Respond to Covid 19 by improving social distance and promoting outside activities. Our district will purchase Appetgy App to allow us to streamline our communication with teachers, students, parents, and the community to share any news or events that are happening in our school. The funds will be used to address learning loss and provide the tools to support academic improvement. \$17,600
- Akin School District plans to meet with a committee of teachers, administration, parents, board members and community to provide input on our back-to-school plan. Akin CCSD will resume the in-person 5 day week, full-day student attendance model. The District will follow all Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) guidelines regarding COVID mitigations. This plan is subject to change based upon updated guidelines from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois State Board of Education. Throughout the school year, this plan will be reviewed and revised as appropriate after seeking and considering public input. Revisions will address the most recently updated safety recommendations by the CDC, provided an alternative format accessible to parents who are individuals with a disability as defined by the ADA, and be made publicly available on the district's website.
